Towards the end of the half, a muffed punt gave Wagner the ball back, but the Seahawks were not able to convert on the opportunity, missing the 48-yard field goal.

## Third Quarter

The connection between Mathis and Barbon picked up right where it left off as the pair connected once again, this time for a 48-yard gain. Temple could not convert the touchdown, however, and were forced to settle for another field goal with just under 12 minutes remaining in the quarter. A quick defensive stand gave the Owls the ball back which the Owls took full advantage of. A



27-yard gain from Mathis to Amad Anderson Jr. moved Temple into Wagner territory. A few plays later, Dobbins ran into the endzone for his third touchdown of the game. On the next Temple drive, Mathis hit an open Kadas Reams deep down the middle for a 44-yard touchdown to extend the Owls' lead to 34-7.

## Fourth Quarter

Empty drives for both sides started the final period before the Owls started to make strides again midway through the quarter thanks to first down receptions from Barbon and tight end Darius Pittman. A second touchdown by Kadas Reams capped off the drive for the Cherry & White to stretch the lead.

## OWLS EARN FIRST AAC VICTORY ON HOMECOMING DAY

PHILADELPHIA – Temple defeated the Memphis Tigers in its conference opener, 34-31. After falling behind 17-0 early in the second quarter, the Owls rallied back, scoring 17 unanswered points in the second quarter to tie the game heading into the break. The Owls fell behind briefly in the third quarter, but a second half touchdown from Tayvon Ruley gave the Owls the lead, and a late touchdown from WR Amad Anderson Jr. sealed the game for Temple.

### How It Happened First Quarter

After picking up a few first downs on its opening drive, Temple punter Adam Barry pinned the Tigers within their own 10-yard line with just over 10 minutes remaining in the quarter. From there, Memphis drove 84 yards on 17 plays before a defensive stand in the red zone, thanks to a pass deflection by CB Cameron Ruiz, forced the Tigers to settle for a field goal. On the next Temple drive, a 34-yard pitch-and-catch from QB D'Wan Mathis to Anderson moved the Owls into Tigers territory, but a turnover on downs a few plays later gave the ball back to the Tigers. A 43-yard reception by Memphis' Sean Dykes set up the Tigers in the red zone as the first quarter drew to a close.

### Second Quarter

On the opening play of the second quarter, a six-yard rush extended the Tigers lead. A second turnover on downs for Temple gave Memphis the ball at the Owls' 35-yard line. On the next play, QB Seth Henigan hit WR Javon Ivory in the end zone to put the Tigers up 17-0. On the ensuing drive, the Owls marched down the field in 17 plays for 75 yards. A fourth-down conversion from RB Ra'Von Bonner kept the drive alive before Ruley moved the chains in the red zone. On fourth-and-one at the Memphis one-yard line, a one-handed catch from WR Jadan Blue put the Owls on the board. The next Memphis drive did not last for long, as CB Keyshawn Paul forced a fumble on the Tigers' second play of the drive. The Owls did not waste any time cutting the deficit with a 15-yard touchdown reception from WR Jose Barbon with just over three minutes remaining in the half. After Temple's defense forced a three-and-out, the Owls' offense capitalized on the opportunity, kicking a 35-yard field goal as time expired to tie the game.

### Third Quarter

After Temple's defense forced a third consecutive empty possession to start the third quarter, a 39-yard rush from Mathis brought the Owls into field goal territory, but a missed field goal kept the game all squared up. Memphis got the first points on the board in the second half after a 69-yard drive resulted in a touchdown midway through the third quarter. On the following drive, the Cherry &



White mounted a drive of their own, driving 75 yards and scoring a one-yard rushing touchdown on fourth-and-goal to take a 24-23 lead heading into the fourth quarter.

### Fourth Quarter

On the following Memphis drive, the Tigers threatened in Temple's red zone once again, but a forced fumble by LB Yvandy Rigby at the one-yard line kept the Owls in front. After a quick first down, the Owls drive stalled out and Temple was forced to give the ball back to the Tigers. The Temple defense held firm once again, however, as Rigby sacked Memphis' quarterback to force a punt. Temple marched down the field once again thanks in large part to a 38-yard run by Edward Saydee and a 15-yard facemask penalty at the end of the play. A defensive stand by Memphis, however, meant that the Owls were forced to

settle for a field goal once again, which Bell knocked through to extend Temple's lead, 27-23. The Tigers moved the ball into Temple territory once again on the next possession, but an incomplete pass on fourth-and-six from the Owls' 43-yard line gave the ball back to the Owls. From there, a 53-yard touchdown from Mathis to Anderson sealed the game for the Owls. A late Memphis touchdown and two-point conversion with 30 seconds remaining trimmed the deficit, but the Owls were able to hold on for the victory.

## OWLS FALL TO HIGH RANKED CINCINNATI IN ANNUAL NATIONALLY TELEVIEWED BLACKOUT GAME

CINCINNATI, Ohio – Temple (3-3, 1-1) dropped its first conference game of the season on Friday night to the #5 ranked Cincinnati Bearcats (5-0, 1-0), 52-3. The Owls fell behind early in the contest as the Bearcats raced out to a 17-0 lead and never looked back. Trailing by 14 points heading into the half-time, the Owls were not able to get back into the game in the second half as the Bearcats scored 35 unanswered to take control of the game.

### How It Happened First Quarter

The Owls moved the ball out to midfield on their opening possession of the game before a stalled drive gave the ball to the Bearcats. From there, Cincinnati drove the ball deep into Temple's territory on its first possession, but a sack from Temple BUBO Yvandy Rigby on third down forced the Bearcats to settle for a field goal. A few drives later, with just over three minutes remaining in the quarter, a muffed punt from Temple set up Cincinnati in the red zone. The Bearcats were able to capitalize on the mistake as two plays later, Cincinnati QB Desmond Ridder tossed a touchdown pass to give the Bearcats a 10-0 lead.

### Second Quarter

After another empty drive for the Cherry & White, the Bearcats mounted a 65-yard drive, capped off by an eight-yard rushing touchdown to stretch the Cincinnati lead to 17 midway through the second quarter. On the following drive, quarterback D'Wan Mathis connected with WR Amad Anderson Jr. and RB Edward Saydee on consecutive plays to move the ball into Cincinnati territory. However, a fumble which was recovered by the Owls a few plays later knocked Temple back for a long field goal try. Kicker Rory Bell was able to answer the call, however, connecting on a 55-yard field goal to put the Owls on the board. On the ensuing drive, the Bearcats drove just outside Temple's red zone, but a defensive stand resulted in a long field goal attempt for Cincinnati which was missed to keep the score at 17-3 heading into the break.



### Third Quarter

On the opening play of the third quarter, the Bearcats struck first in the second half, as Cincinnati RB Jerome Ford ran into the end zone for a 75-yard touchdown. After being forced to a three-and-out on the next drive, a 58-yard punt by Adam Barry pinned the Bearcats inside their own 10-yard line. The Owls' forced a three-and-out of their own to force a Bearcats' punt, but another muffed punt by Temple resulted in its second turnover of the game. A couple of big plays later and Cincinnati tacked on another touchdown to stretch the lead to 31-3. A few minutes later, Cincinnati scored touchdowns on back-to-back drives to take a 45-3 lead into the final period.

### Fourth Quarter

A Cincinnati touchdown added to the Bearcats lead.
