THE OPENING KICKOFF

- Houston and USF are meeting for the ninth time. Houston leads the all-time series 6-2 highlighted by six consecutive victories (2013-present). The six-game win streak is tied for Houston's third-longest active streak against an opponent, trailing only Detroit Mercy (7) and Rice (7). USF (0-6) and ECU (0-4) are the only active American programs to have not defeated Houston in league play.
- Houston is 46-17 in October since 2006 including a 25-9 mark at home. Houston has won six straight in the month (Oct. 1, 2021-present).
- The Cougars made some history during their 2021 matchup at South Florida. For the first time in program history, Houston had multiple 100-yard receivers (**Nathaniel Dell** - 164 yards; **KeSean Carter** - 123 yards) and multiple 100-yard rushers in a game (**Ta'Zawn Henry** - 130 rushing, **Alton McCaskill IV** - 125 rushing). Henry's 97-yard rushing touchdown with 10:04 to play in the third quarter was the longest rush in American Athletic Conference history and longest rush in Houston program history.
- After struggling with penalties for much of the season, Houston looks to turn the corner. The Cougars' 25 penalty yards last time out at Navy matched their fewest over the last three seasons (2020-present). Houston's 25 penalty yards were its ninth fewest in a conference road game over the last 20 years.
- Three was the magic number at Navy. Houston senior quarterback (#3) **Clayton Tune** set a career high and matched a Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium record with five passing touchdowns. Tune became the sixth FBS quarterback to throw for 5+ touchdowns without an interception in a road game this season. Linebacker (#3) **Donavan Mutin** recorded a career high 13 tackles, the most for a Cougar since **Grant Stuard** logged 15 stops at UConn on Oct. 19, 2019.
- Houston took a lead into halftime for the first time this season last week at Navy (21-7). The Cougars have now won 11 consecutive games when leading at halftime. The Cougars have won 13 straight when limiting opponents under 24 points (Navy - 20). With **Stacy Sneed's** 100 rushing yards, the Cougars have won six consecutive when having a 100-yard rusher.
- Houston's special teams have been just that. The Cougars rank 18th nationally with two blocked kicks and are 18th nationally in kick return average (23.81) highlighted by a 100-yard kickoff return touchdown by **Jayce Rogers** at Memphis. The Cougars have also recovered an onside kick (**Christian Trahan** at Memphis) while punter **Laine Wilkins** ranks seventh nationally in punting average (45.6).
- Houston's offense has been hard to stop on third downs. Houston ranks 16th nationally in third down conversions (49.1%) and has converted on 50+ percent of third downs in five of its seven games. Houston converted 42.1% in 2021, 40.0% in 2020 and 34.8% in 2019.
- Houston is the preseason favorite to win The American Athletic Conference and is in search of its second American title and first since 2015. Currently, Houston (2-1) and UCF (2-1) are tied for third in the league standings behind Tulane (4-0) and Cincinnati (3-0).
- On Oct. 7 at Memphis, Houston became the first FBS program in 130 tries this season to overcome a 19+ point deficit in the fourth quarter. The Cougars' 19-point comeback matched their fifth largest in school history. It was the program's second largest in a true road game. Houston's 26 fourth quarter points were its most since scoring 28 at Cincinnati on Sept. 15, 2016.
- Houston wide receiver **Nathaniel Dell** has hauled in five touchdowns over the last three games, upping his Houston career total to 23. Dell's 23 receiving touchdowns since the start of the 2020 season ranks tied for third nationally with Alabama's DeVonta Smith. His 2,384 yards in that span ranks sixth in the country. Matthew Wright's 41-yard field goal gave UCF a 24-3 lead early in the second half. Ward rallied the Cougars with TD runs for 1 and 14 yards and a 6-yard scoring pass to Romello Brooker. Duke Catalan added a 12-yard rushing TD.

TEAM NOTES

• Five of Houston's seven games have come down to the final drive including a school-record three overtime games. In its season opener, Houston's defense forced an incomplete pass on UTSA's 2-point opportunity in the third overtime to seal the win. On Sept. 24, Houston locked up a 34-27 win on a Rice incomplete pass on 1st and Goal from the 9-yard line as time expired. The Cougars took a one-point lead with 18 seconds left at Memphis and closed the game on an **Atlias Bell** sack at the Memphis 38-yard line.

• Houston's first seven opponents are a combined 32-21 with six of the 21 losses coming against AP Top 25 opponents. Three of Houston's first seven opponents (Texas Tech, Kansas and Tulane) have been ranked inside the Top 25 at some point this season with the Green Wave currently at No. 23 in the AP Top 25.

• Houston has had its share of tough luck with injuries this season. The Cougars were without four starters (WR **Joseph Manjack IV**, FS **Gervarrius Owens**, CB **Art Green** and DE **Derek Parish**) in an American-opening loss to Tulane. Parish, who set an American Conference record for sacks (4.5) and tackles for loss (6.5) at Texas Tech, is out for the season (torn bicep). Cornerback **Alex Hogan** will miss the remainder of the season after suffering a left knee injury at Memphis.

• Houston has seen first-hand how small the margin for error is in its losses this season. Texas Tech covered 46 yards in 34 seconds at the end of regulation to set up the game-tying field goal and converted a 4th and 20 during the first overtime of an eventual 33-30 double-overtime victory. Tulane used an 11-play, 75-yard drive, scoring on a fourth down from the 3-yard line with 39 seconds remaining to tie the game during an eventual 27-24 overtime victory.

• The Cougars rank ninth nationally with 7.9 tackles for loss per game and are 29th in team sacks with 2.71 per game. Houston's **D'Anthony Jones** is graded as the nation's fourth-best edge rusher (89.8) by Pro Football Focus (PFF) and ranks seventh in pass rush (91.0). **Nelson Ceaser** is graded as the nation's 20th-best edge defender (86.4) while **Latrell Bankston** checks in at No. 17 nationally by pass rush grade (83.7) among interior defenders.

• Houston has scored 10+ points in 105 consecutive games (Sept. 2014-present), which ranks second nationally among active streaks (Alabama, 153). The Cougars have scored 10+ points in 49 straight home contests (Sept. 2014-present).

• With a pair of interceptions last time out at Navy, the Cougars have forced 10 turnovers this season. Houston's 222 turnovers forced since 2013 ranks fifth nationally, trailing only Louisiana Tech (236), Clemson (233), Ohio State (228) and UCF (223).

• Houston kick returner **Jayce Rogers** is tied for the national lead in kickoff return touchdowns (1); wide receiver **Nathaniel Dell** is fourth in receiving touchdowns (8) and seventh in receptions per game (7.3); punter **Laine Wilkins** is seventh in punting average (45.6); quarterback **Clayton Tune** is 19th in completions per game (23.14), passing touchdowns (17) and points responsible for per game (17.4); defensive lineman **D'Anthony Jones** is 21st in forced fumbles (0.29).

LAST DANCE

» The 2022 season will be Houston's final in The American Athletic Conference before leaving for the Big 12 Conference. The Big 12 will be the seventh league in which Houston Athletics competes during its award-winning history.

» The 2022 season marks the 10th year of competition in The American for the Cougars. Houston has reached the league's title game twice in the nine-year span including winning the 2015 American title. The Cougars are 47-26 all-time in American competition.

» Houston is joined alongside BYU, Cincinnati and UCF among Big 12 Conference newcomers for 2023. The four schools will compete against current Big 12 members Baylor, Iowa State, Kansas, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas Tech and West Virginia.

SINGLE DIGITS

» Each season, Houston Football players vote to determine who will wear, or retain, single-digit jersey numbers. Outside of being a team captain, those who wear single digits garner the highest respect from their teammates.

» New single-digit honorees for the 2022 season include No. 2 **Gervarrius Owens**, who previously wore No. 32; No. 6 **Jayce Rogers**, who previously wore No. 16; No. 8 **KeSean Carter**, who previously wore No. 20 and No. 9 **Nelson Ceaser**, who wore No. 96.

TRANSFER TRACKER

» Houston took advantage of the transfer portal during the offseason. The Cougars have seven players from Power 5 conferences including two wide receivers, two linebackers, one quarterback, one running back and one offensive lineman.

SAN ANTONIO – Dana Holgorsen would prefer Clayton Tune not run the ball out of concern for his health. The Houston coach knew he could not stop his senior quarterback from doing so, though. And neither could UTSA.

Tune leaped over a defender to score on a 13-yard run and the 24th-ranked Cougars escaped with 37-35 victory over UTSA in three overtimes on Sept. 3.

Per NCAA rules for a third overtime, Tune's winning run was a 2-point conversion. The Roadrunners were unable to match the score as their final pass floated out of bounds.

Tune was 22 of 32 for 206 yards and three touchdowns and rushed for 51 yards and a TD.

Houston rallied from a 14-point deficit in the second half at the Alamodome to snap UTSA's 10-game home winning streak.

Houston dominated the final quarter, maintaining possession for 10 minutes, 30 seconds in driving 77 yards on 18 plays. The drive ended with Bubba Baxa kicking a 35-yard field goal with 26 seconds remaining for a 24-21 lead.

Tune ran for three first-down conversions in the final drive of regulation, including two during which he scrambled out of the pocket after not finding an open receiver.

UTSA matched the feat in far less time, driving 55 yards in 23 seconds for a 37-yard field goal by Jared Sackett to force overtime.

Baxa and Sackett kicked matching field goals in the first overtime.

After Tune scored on a 1-yard run and threw for the 2-point conversion in the second overtime, Roadrunners quarterback Frank Harris matched the output by running in the conversion after tossing a touchdown pass to De'Corian Clark.

LUBBOCK, Texas– Donovan Smith put Texas Tech at risk of losing with his arm.

The sophomore quarterback rescued the Red Raiders with his legs.

Smith ran 9 yards for a touchdown in the second overtime, lifting Texas Tech to a 33-30 victory over No. 25 Houston on Sept. 10.

A back-and-forth finish ended with the Red Raiders (2-0) beating a ranked nonconference opponent in the regular season for the first time since 1989, a span of 14 games.

It was the last meeting between the former Southwest Conference rivals before they become league foes again when the Cougars move from the American Athletic to the Big 12 next year.

After Houston's Bubba Baxa opened the second OT with a 20-yard field goal, Smith broke into the open field and ran untouched to the end zone, sending Texas Tech students and fans streaming onto the field.

Baxa kicked a go-ahead 35-yard field goal with 37 seconds remaining in regulation after Gervarrius Owens returned Smith's third interception to the Texas Tech 21 in the final two minutes.

Smith answered with a 27-yard scramble on the next play, sparking a drive to a tying 47-yard field goal from Trey Wolff with three seconds to go. Wolff replaced Gino Garcia, who missed from 45 earlier in the fourth quarter.

The Cougars (1-1) erased a 17-3 halftime deficit, getting even early in the fourth quarter when Jayce Rogers stepped in front of a pass from Smith and returned it 54 yards for a TD. Still, Houston's 12-game regular-season winning streak ended.

Houston had 11 penalties for 121 yards, including two personal fouls on the same possession that twice let the Red Raiders keep the ball when the Cougars would have taken possession in the first half.

Houston also trailed by two touchdowns in the second half of another overtime game in last week's opener, rallying from 21-7 down entering the fourth quarter for a 37-35 double-overtime victory over UTSA.

Both teams scored touchdowns in the first overtime after backing themselves up. Smith converted on fourth-and-20 with a 21-yard completion to Jerand Bradley. The Red Raiders forced the second OT on Tahj Brooks' 4-yard scoring run.

Tune faced second-and-21 to open overtime before a 19-yard completion to Nathaniel Dell, who had seven catches for 120 yards and a 35-yard punt return. Three plays later, he threw a 15-yard TD pass to Matthew Golden.

HOUSTON – Jalon Daniels threw for 158 yards and three touchdowns and rushed for 123 yards and two scores as Kansas improved to 3-0 for the first time since 2009 with a 48-30 win over Houston on Sept. 17.

Daniels finished 14 of 23 and threw touchdown passes of 5, 60 and 8 yards. He had touchdown runs of 12 and 9 yards.

“I thought Jalon was excellent today,” Kansas coach Lance Leipold said. “He made some big plays, scrambling, keeping drives alive, saw some things, didn’t hesitate. Statistically, he probably didn’t get off to a great start, but I think again, a very solid day.”

He found 11 different receivers and threw touchdown passes to Torry Locklin, Jared Casey and Luke Grimm.

“We have a lot of people who are able to make plays with the ball in their hands in our offense,” Daniels said. “I feel like (offensive coordinator Andy Kotelnicki) realizes that, so I feel like he does a great job of being able to put guys in situations to be able to get the ball.”

Kansas finished with 438 yards, including 280 rushing yards. The Jayhawks won back-to-back road games for the first time since 2007.

After Houston opened up a 14-0 lead midway through the first quarter, Kansas answered with 28 straight points on a 12-yard touchdown run by Daniels, an 8-yard touchdown run by Daniel Hishaw Jr. and touchdown passes of 5 yards and 60 yards by Daniels to open up a 14-point lead with a minute left in the first half.

Clayton Tune was 22 of 31 for 260 yards, a touchdown and an interception. He also rushed for 63 yards and a touchdown. Houston (1-2) finished with 446 total yards.

Brandon Campbell had 48 rushing yards and a score, and Ta’Zawn Henry finished with 56 rushing yards and a touchdown and five catches for 107 yards and a score for Houston. Nathaniel Dell caught six passes for 76 yards.

HOUSTON – Houston Football’s fourth quarter rally came up short as Tulane drove the field late to force overtime, eventually taking down the Cougars 27-24 on Sept. 30 in the American Athletic Conference opener from TDECU Stadium.

An early defensive showdown turned into an offensive shootout late as Houston (2-3, 0-1 The American) scored 14 unanswered points in the fourth quarter before Tulane (4-1, 1-0 The American) drove 75 yards in 11 plays, tying the contest on a 3-yard touchdown reception and extra point.

Quarterback Clayton Tune passed for 208 yards on 22 of 33 passing alongside two touchdowns. Alongside his 56 rushing yards, Tune surpassed the 10,000-yard career total yards mark (10,023), becoming the fourth player in program history to accomplish the feat, joining Case Keenum (20,114 yards), Kevin Kolb (13,715 yards) and Greg Ward Jr. (11,080 yards).

Wide receiver Nathaniel Dell hauled in eight receptions for two touchdowns and 73 yards. Dell’s two receiving touchdowns were the 19th and 20th since the start of the 2020 season which ranks tied for fifth nationally in that span.


After forcing a Green Wave three-and-out on the following drive, the Cougars drove 80 yards down the field on 10 plays capped off by a Tune 14-yard touchdown pass to Dell in the right corner of the end zone to give Houston its first lead of the game at 21-14 with 3:04 remaining.


In overtime, Houston regained the lead with a 36-yard field goal by kicker Bubba Baxa, but a 10-yard touchdown pass from Horton to Tyjae Spears on the following drive sealed the win for Tulane.

MEMPHIS, Tenn. – University of Houston senior quarterback Clayton Tune threw a pair of touchdown passes inside the final two minutes as Houston scored 26 fourth-quarter points to stun Memphis 33-32 on Oct. 7 inside Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium.

Tune tossed a 13-yard touchdown pass to senior wide receiver KeSean Carter that capped a 12-play, 75-yard drive to pull Houston to 32-26 with 1:17 to play. Houston took possession following the ensuing onside kick on senior tight end Christian Trahan’s recovery. Tune and Carter connected again six plays later for the game-winner on a 2-yard touchdown with 18 seconds to play.

It tied as the fifth biggest comeback in school history. It also was the second come-from-behind win over 19+ points in the fourth quarter against the Tigers in school history (The Cougars trailed 34-14 with 14:52 left in the fourth quarter on Nov. 14, 2015, before taking a 35-34 win).

Houston (3-3 • 1-1 American) has won two straight against Memphis (4-2 • 2-1 American) since ending a five-game losing streak to the Tigers in a 31-13 home win last season.

Tune finished 36-of-57 passing for 366 yards with three touchdowns. Redshirt freshman wide receiver Samuel Brown had nine receptions for 116 yards, and junior wide receiver Nathaniel Dell made 10 catches for 81 yards and a score. Carter finished with four receptions for 36 yards and a pair of scores.

Memphis looked to be headed toward an easy victory when Seth Henigan threw a lateral to Gabriel Rogers near the sideline. Rogers then avoided three defenders and ran back toward the logo and lofted a pass to Asa Martin in the end zone for a 41-yard touchdown that stretched the Memphis lead to 26-7 with 14:50 remaining.

Senior defensive back Jayce Rogers returned a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown midway through the fourth quarter for Houston, but Chris Howard made his fourth field goal, a 39-yarder, to push the Tigers’ lead to 32-19 with 4:04 to play.

OFFENSIVE OVERVIEW

Houston averaged 35.9 points per game in 2021 and has provided senior quarterback **Clayton Tune** with additional weapons in 2022. Through seven games this season, Tune has been responsible for 124 points, a mark that ranks second in The American and 23rd nationally.

The Cougars went out and added four-star freshman wide receiver **Matthew Golden**, USC transfer wide receiver **Joseph Manjack IV** and West Virginia transfer **Sam Brown** among others. Tune's top two targets in wide receiver **Nathaniel Dell** and tight end **Christian Trahan** also return. A season ago, Houston ranked 23rd nationally in passing offense (271.6).

After losing running back **Alton McCaskill IV** to a knee injury in the spring, Houston has relied heavily on a host of backs including senior **Ta'Zawn Henry** and USC transfer **Brandon Campbell**. **Stacy Sneed** has also seen steady time this season.

Houston is not short on experience up front, led by left tackle **Patrick Paul** who started all 14 games a season ago. **Jack Freeman**, who appeared in 13 games on the line a season ago, has made the transition to center.

- **Ta'Zawn Henry (Sr.)** – Became the 31st Cougar in program history with a rushing and receiving touchdown in a single game, doing so against Kansas on Sept. 17 ... appeared in 13 games as a running back in his first season at Houston in 2021 ... finished second on the team in rushing yards setting a new career-high in the process with 524 yards ... finished second on the team with seven rushing touchdowns ... with the loss of **Alton McCaskill IV** for the season, Henry leads group as the most experienced.

- **Brandon Campbell (R-Fr.)** – Spent one season at USC before transferring to Houston ... recorded 12 rushes for 53 rushing yards and one reception for 16 yards in three games for the Trojans.

- **Stacy Sneed (R-Fr.)** – Rushed for a career high 100 yards, becoming the second Houston running back to eclipse the 100-yard mark in a game, doing so at navy ... did not see action in 2020 or 2021 with Houston.

TIGHT END

- **Christian Trahan (Sr.)** – Started in 11 games as the team's every day tight end in 2021 ... appeared in all 14 games, recording single-season career highs in receptions (37) and receiving yards (398) ... finished second on the team in receptions (37) and fourth on the team in receiving yards (398) ... recorded career-high six receptions in two games (vs. Texas Tech, ECU) ... scored touchdowns in back-to-back games against Tulane and ECU.

DEFENSIVE OVERVIEW

With Defensive Coordinator **Doug Belk** at the helm, Houston's Third Ward Defense allowed 20.4 points per game and held opponents to 3.4 yards a rush alongside 45 sacks a season ago. The unit will look to reload following key losses of defensive lineman **Logan Hall** and cornerback **Marcus Jones**, among others.

Senior **Gervarius Owens**, a first-team all-conference selection a season ago, and **Donavan Mutin**, who led the team in tackles a season ago, are back with sights set on an American title. The duo highlights a unit returning 62% of tackles and 82% of fumbles forced from 2021.

The Cougars defense also added immediate impact players in transfers **Jamal Morris** (Oklahoma) and **Trimarcus Cheeks** (Samford) have spent time linebacker during the early part of the season. Overall, Houston returns 19 lettermen defensively and six starters.

With his 100-yard kickoff return touchdown at Memphis, senior defensive back **Jayce Rogers** became the second player in program history (**Brandon Wilson**, 2015) to record a kickoff return TD and interception return TD in a single season. Rogers took a 54-yard interception to the house at Texas Tech on Sept. 10.

Houston arguably housed the nation's top special team's unit a season ago. The Cougars led the nation in blocked kicks (6). **Marcus Jones** was the only player nationally with multiple punt return touchdowns and multiple kick return touchdowns while **Dalton Witherspoon** capped his historic career by tacking on 16 field goals while connecting on 59 of 60 extra points and punter **Laine Wilkins** averaged 41.8 yards per punt including 13 of 50-plus yards.

The Cougars will be in search of a new threat in the return game. Wide receiver **Nathaniel Dell** contributed 201 kick return yards on 13 attempts and **Ta'Zawn Henry** added 111 yards on 13 attempts, but no returning Cougar returned more than one punt.

HEAD COACH DANA HOLGORSEN

FOURTH SEASON AT HOUSTON (23-18) | 12TH SEASON OVERALL (84-59)

• Dana Holgorsen was named head coach at Houston on Jan. 1, 2019, after eight seasons as head coach at West Virginia. Throughout his career, Holgorsen has had 22 players earn All-America honors, win 11 national awards and 14 national award finalist honors. In his three years as the Houston head coach, seven Cougars have been selected in the NFL draft including one first-round pick.

• Under Holgorsen's leadership in 2021, the Cougars won 12-plus games for just the third time in program history. Houston won 11 consecutive games, its longest stretch since 2011, en route to an appearance in The American Football Championship. In the 2021 Birmingham Bowl, Houston knocked off Auburn to clinch the program's first bowl victory since 2015. Houston was one of six teams nationally to rank in the top 20 in both points per game (35.9) and opponent points per game (20.4). For the second time in his coaching career, Holgorsen tutored a Paul Hornung Award winner as consensus All-American Marcus Jones captured the award in 2021.

• Holgorsen closed his tenure at West Virginia as the second-winningest coach in Mountaineer history with an eight-year record of 61-41. His 61 wins trailed only College Football Hall of Famer Don Nehlen for most wins in West Virginia history.

• He led the Mountaineers to bowl games in seven of his eight seasons including each of the last five seasons. His first season at West Virginia ended with a 70-33 rout of Clemson in the Orange Bowl. Throughout his career, Holgorsen has had 21 players earn All-America honors, win 10 national awards and 14 national award finalist honors.

• He has displayed his ability to prepare players for the next level as West Virginia had 10 NFL draft picks in first three rounds in the past seven years, second most in Big 12 with at least one Top-15 draft pick in four of the past seven years. In all, he had four NFL Top-15 draft picks during the past seven years, the most in the Big 12, and 20 players drafted in seven years at WVU, tied for second-most in the Big 12 during that span.

• An offensive genius, his passing offenses and total offensive output have ranked in the Top 10 nationally all but four years during the 14-year span since he became offensive coordinator at Texas Tech in 2005. He's had eight quarterbacks pass for 4,000 or more yards and 10 throw for 30 or more touchdowns in a season with 20 receivers finishing with 1,000 or more yards in a season, including 11 finish with 90 or more receptions and 16 finish with double figure TD receptions in a season. He is the only coach in West Virginia history to have coached a team with at least 450 rushing yards in a game (Oklahoma, 2012) and at least 450 yards passing in a game (six times).

• West Virginia has been ranked in both major polls at least one week in seven of his eight years including the entire 2018 season with several weeks inside the top 10. He had 10 wins over Top 25 opponents in his eight-year tenure at WVU.

• Holgorsen had a successful first season at WVU in 2011, coaching the Mountaineers to a 10-3 record, the Big East championship and a 70-33 Orange Bowl rout of Clemson. The victory was WVU's third Bowl Championship Series championship in school history and earned Holgorsen the First-Year Coach of the Year award by the Football Writers Association of America.

• Before West Virginia, Holgorsen spent the 2010 season as offensive coordinator at Oklahoma State. He was a finalist for the 2010 Broyles Award, given to the nation's top assistant, and also named the Rivals.com Offensive Coordinator of the Year. The Cowboys led the nation in total offense during the regular season and finished No. 2 in passing offense and No. 3 in total and scoring offense. OSU averaged 520.23 yards per game in total offense, including 345.9 passing yards and 44.23 points per game..

• Postseason accolades rolled in for Holgorsen's offensive players as quarterback Brandon Weeden became the first OSU passer to earn first team all-Big 12 honors. He was a finalist for the Manning Award, given to the top quarterback in the nation. Receiver Justin Blackmon won the 2010 Biletnikoff Award, given to the top receiver in the nation, and running back Kendall Hunter was a finalist for the Doak Walker Award, given to the nation's top running back. Weeden, Hunter and Blackmon became only the second trio in NCAA history to pass for at least 3,000 yards, run for more than 1,500 yards and finish with more than 1,500 yards receiving in the same season.

• During his two-year tenure with Houston, his offenses put up explosive numbers, accounting for 563 yards of total offense per game, passing for 433.7 yards per game and totaling more than 42.2 points per game. His offense ranked No. 3 in total offense in 2008 and No. 1 in 2009. His quarterback, Case Keenum, led the nation in total offense in 2008 and 2009, totaling 403.2 yards per game as a sophomore and 416.4 yards his junior season. He also ranked among the Top 10 nationally in pass efficiency both years.

• Before his two-year stint with the Cougars, Holgorsen was a member of the coaching staff at Texas Tech from 2000-07, serving as the inside receivers coach from 2000-04, before being elevated to co-offensive coordinator in 2005 and offensive coordinator in 2006-07. During his time in Lubbock, his offenses increased the amount of yardage from 324.8 yards of total offense to 529.6, an increase of more than 200 yards per game.

• In his two years as offensive coordinator, his squad was nationally ranked No. 8 in 2006 and No. 3 in 2007. In 2007, Texas Tech led the nation in passing (470.31), was No. 2 in total offense (529.62) and was No. 7 in scoring offense (40.9). Quarterback Graham Harrell led the nation in total offense and Biletnikoff Award winner Michael Crabtree led the nation in receptions per game and receiving yards per game. In 2006, the Red Raiders ranked No. 3 nationally in passing offense and No. 6 in total offense. Harrell once again was outstanding, finishing No. 3 nationally in total offense with 344.38 yards per game. Texas Tech led the nation in passing in 2005, was No. 4 in scoring offense (39.4) and No. 6 in total offense (495.83)

• Holgorsen also spent time at Valdosta State (1993-95) as the quarterbacks, receivers and special teams coach, Mississippi College (1996-98) as the quarterbacks, receivers and special teams coach and at Wingate (1999) as the quarterbacks and receivers coach. While at Valdosta State in 1994, Chris Hatcher won the Harlon Hill Trophy, the NCAA Division II Player of the Year award, by the second largest vote margin in the 17-year history of the award. Hatcher won the award after throwing for 4,076 yards and 55 touchdowns, against just 10 interceptions, while completing 367 of 508 passes. Hatcher led Division II in passing efficiency during the regular season and directed VSU to its first Division II post-season appearance.

TDECU STADIUM

BERT F. WINSTON BAND COMPLEX

A 39,089-square foot building on the east end of TDECU Stadium housing the Spirit of Houston Band Recital Halls and classroom spaces, Coach Bill Yeoman Hall and the UH Athletics Ticket Office.

COACH BILL YEOMAN HALL

A 2,000-square foot tribute area to University of Houston history located on the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium. Serves as a gameday club for ticket holders in section 129 and north side loge boxes.

DORIS NANTZ PRESS BOX

The Doris Nantz Press Box contains seats for 70 working media along with a press dining area and a wired photographer work room.

FIELD SURFACE

The synthetic surface installed at TDECU Stadium is the S5-M manufactured by UBU. S5-M, a Speed Series product, is a slit-film turf blade with a sand/rubber combination for infill. It is the same surface installed at the Houston Football practice facility. The turf is designed to host a multitude of events, including but not limited to, high school football games, band practice, specific UH intramural events, etc.

LEGENDS PLAZA

A plaza area recognizing the proud tradition of Houston Football at the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium.

LOCKER ROOM (HOME)

State-of-the-art 5,000-square foot home locker room located at the southeast corner of TDECU Stadium. Views exclusive to the club area give those fans an opportunity to watch team members travel from the locker room to the field level.

LOCKER ROOM (VISITOR)

Located at the west end of the stadium with a field entrance in the northwest corner of TDECU Stadium. Multi-functional locker room can be split and serve two separate teams simultaneously.

ORIENTATION OF STADIUM

East-to-west giving fans and television audiences a spectacular view of the downtown Houston skyline while also keeping in line with the University's grid system and creating more efficient parking. Sun and shade studies were also conducted to improve the best level of comfort for Houston fans and not affect student-athletes.

PARTY PATIOS

Four (4) open-air lower bowl party decks with 24 armchairs (20 inches wide). Both the east and west lower bowl end zones contain a party deck with two located on the north lower bowl sideline.

PREMIUM SEATING

Consists of 5,000 of the 40,000 seats in the TDECU Stadium.

Club Area

The stylish club area is the ultimate Houston Football experience. With 12,400 square feet of multi-purpose club area overlooking the field of play, fans with access to the club area enjoy upscale food and drinks while receiving first-class hospitality on game days. The climate-controlled area also feature high-definition televisions and private restrooms. The area is also available to host special events, meetings and classes.

Suites

Spanning from end zone to end zone on the south side of TDECU Stadium with a view of downtown Houston, 26 premium suites each containing 12 outside padded arm chairs, four inside bar stools and entertainment area. Houston fans enjoy comfort and style in these 325-square foot suites with individual upscale service and amenities.

Loge Boxes

42 loge boxes each containing four seats and high-definition monitors located throughout the stadium.

Club Seats

766 armchair style padded club seats that are 22 inches wide and located in the lower bowl of TDECU Stadium.

Additional Premium Seating

2,778 armchair seats that are 20 inches wide and 1,210 benches with backs with the majority located in the lower bowl of TDECU Stadium.

SUITE DECKS

Two (2) open-air party suites located on the suite level positioned at each end (east and west end) of the suites. Each open-air suite contains 60 padded armchairs (21 inches wide).

TICKET OFFICE

The University of Houston Athletics Ticket Office is located on the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium facing Cullen Blvd. The facility has eight exterior ticket-selling windows along with two interior windows in the ticket office lobby in close proximity to the stadium parking garage.

VIDEO BOARD

State-of-the-art HD-video board located on the west end of TDECU Stadium. Sized at 2,584 square feet (38 feet high, 68 feet wide), the board was designed by Panasonic using Nichia technology.
