UAB HOSTS USF FOR AAC HOME OPENER:

The UAB football team will look to snap a four game losing streak on Saturday when the Blazers host their first AAC home game against USF. UAB is coming off a tough 35-23 loss at Tulane, while South Florida defeated Navy 44-30 last week in Annapolis and enters the game leading the AAC at 2-0. Saturday is UAB's seventh annual Children's Harbor game in which the Blazers honor patients from the nearby Children's Hospital located on UAB's campus.

FRESHMAN AMARE THOMAS EMERGING AT WIDEOUT:

Freshman Amare Thomas, who is just 17 years old, is emerging as a playmaker at wide receiver. He leads the team in receptions (23) and is second in receiving yards (227). In his last two games (at No. 1 Georgia and at Tulane), Thomas has hauled in 17 catches for 159 yards and one touchdown. He had nine catches for 60 yards and a touchdown at No. 1 Georgia, and followed that up with eight catches for 99 yards at Tulane.

FUMBLES RECOVERED:

UAB is tied for the national lead for fumbles recovered (8) with WKU. The Blazers have recovered four fumbles in each of their last two games at Georgia and at Tulane. Michael Fairbanks II has a team high three forced fumbles this season, while he and Desmond Little each caused a fumble in UAB's last game, each of which the Blazers recovered.

JACOB ZENO ON RECORD PACE:

Quarterback Jacob Zeno is on record pace this season and is playing at an elite level for UAB. In five games, Zeno has thrown for 1,442 yards (288.4/game) and ranks third nationally in completions per game (31.4) and fourth in completion percentage (75.5). He is on pace to set all of UAB's major single season passing records and leads an offense that is averaging 420.2 yards per game.

CHILDREN'S HARBOR:

Saturday marks the seventh annual Children's Harbor game in which the Blazers will honor 100 patients from the nearby Children's Hospital located on UAB's campus. UAB will be wearing the names of patients on the back of their alternate gray and lime jerseys. This is a partnership that dates back to 2016 and UAB has represented over 700 families throughout the past seven Children's Harbor game. Children's Harbor's mission is to strengthen families of seriously ill children through refuge, respite and resources. These unique, no-cost services are offered at both "The Harbor" Family Center located at Children's of Alabama in Birmingham, and at the Lake Martin retreat facility in Alexander City. Children's Harbor has been in service since 1989.

UAB Director of Athletics Mark Ingram named 14-year NFL veteran quarterback and Super Bowl XXXV Champion Trent Dilfer as UAB Football's seventh head coach in program history on Nov. 30, 2022.

Trent is an outstanding man, husband and father with tremendous character who fits our department's core values of winning championships, graduating with honors and making a difference in our community."

Dilfer most recently spent the last four years as the head coach of Lipscomb Academy in Nashville where he led the Mustangs to back-to-back TSSAA D2-AA State Championship titles. Dilfer compiled an overall record of 44-10 in his four years and a mark of 26-1 in the last two seasons.

Dilfer was selected sixth overall in the 1994 NFL Draft by the Tampa

Bay Buccaneers and threw for 20,518 yards and 113 touchdowns during his 14-year career. In 2000, he led the Baltimore Ravens to a

34-7 victory over the New York Giants in Super Bowl XXXV. He was

named to the Pro Bowl in 1997 and was the recipient of the Bart

Starr Award and Ed Block Courage Award in 2003.

"This is an exciting day for UAB Football and the entire UAB community of students, faculty, staff, alumni and fans," said UAB President Ray Watts. "At UAB, excellence is the standard, and it is clear that Coach Dilfer will personify that standard. He is a wellnetworked Super Bowl champion with a national platform, and a successful coach who has helped teams and individuals – including some of the NFL's most elite quarterbacks — reach their potential. "I thank the search committee for their dedication to this process, as well as the University of Alabama System Office and the UA System Board of Trustees for their continued support of our great institution and UAB Athletics every day," Watts said. "I also thank Bryant Vincent for serving as our interim head football coach and leading the football staff and team during a critical time in the program's history. We are proud and appreciative of their dedication."

"Having the opportunity to lead such a quality program like UAB is one that I am beyond excited about," Dilfer said. "The investments the university has made for UAB Football aligns with my vision of taking this program to new heights as we join the American Athletic Conference and compete annually for the highest prize of playing in the College Football Playoff. I would like to thank President Ray Watts, Director of Athletics Mark Ingram and the entire search committee for their commitment to excellence and for trusting in season, Dilfer declared for the NFL Draft, forgoing his senior season. me as we venture into this new era of UAB Football together."

Dilfer attended Fresno State where he was the starting quarterback and was named the WAC Offensive Player of the Year in 1993 after throwing for 3,799 yards and 30 touchdowns. Following his junior

In 2008, Dilfer began a nine-year broadcasting career as an analyst on ESPN for a variety of programs, including Monday Night Countdown and NFL Primetime. He was nominated for a Sports Emmy in 2012 for Outstanding Sports Personality in the Studio Analyst category.

Dilfer also helped establish the Elite 11 Academy which began in 2009 and was launched to train elite-level high school guarterbacks. His alumni include 27 of the 32 current NFL starting quarterbacks and 14 of the past 15 Heisman Trophy winning quarterbacks. Currently, 60 of the 64 Power 5 starting quarterbacks in 2022 attended the Elite 11 Finals or Elite 11 Regional.

Dilfer and his wife Cassandra have three daughters, Maddie, Tori and Delaney, and a son Trevin, who passed away in 2003.

"Trent is a proven winner on and off the field at all levels and will be a tremendous leader for our program," Ingram said. "He is a Super Bowl-winning quarterback who played the game at its highest level for many years, and he has coached some of the top quarterbacks who are currently NFL franchise players. Trent's goals and vision for our program is to lead UAB to the College Football Playoff and we have no doubt that he is the right coach to lead our transition in the American Athletic Conference. BIRMINGHAM — Quarterback Jacob Zeno set a school record with 38 pass completions to lead the UAB football team past North Carolina A&T 35-6 on Thursday night at Protective Stadium.

Zeno was 38-of-41 overall for 291 yards and three touchdowns. He surpassed the previous record of 33 completions held by John Whitcomb set back in 1994. The three touchdown passes were also a career high.

Zeno's completion percentage of 92.7 percent was also the fourth highest completion percentage in American Athletic Conference history

The victory was also the first for Head Coach Trent Dilfer and UAB has now won eight straight season openers.

Defensively, UAB held North Carolina A&T to just 163 yards of total offense and just 16 total passing yards. Linebacker Jackson Bratton led the charge with a career-high 12 tackles, two sacks and one forced fumble. Overall, UAB had six sacks and nine TFL.

UAB (1-0) won the toss, elected to receive, and marched straight down the field on 13 plays to score a touchdown on its first possession of the season. Jermaine Brown Jr. capped the drive with a 10-yard touchdown run to give UAB the early lead.

The Aggies converted a 37-yard field goal on their first possession, but the Blazer surged ahead with another touchdown run from Brown Jr., this time a 4-yard score, to give the Blazers a 14-3 lead at the 12:07 mark of the second quarter. For Brown, it was his 20th career rushing touchdown.

UAB was unable to score on its third possession, but the Blazers turned right back around and scored on their fourth possession with :25 second left for a commanding 21-3 halftime lead. The touchdown was an incredible throw and catch from Zeno to Tejhaun Palmer in the corner of the end zone.

Zeno was 18-of-19 in the first half for 129 yards and a touchdown.

A 34-yard touchdown pass to T.J. Jones late in the third and a 4-yard pass to Iverson "Strap" Hooks in the fourth capped the scoring for UAB as they cruised to the 29-point victory.

Zeno found 13 different receivers throughout the evening with five players sharing a game-high four catches and nine players having at least three.

The Blazers now hit the road for a Week 2 contest at Georgia Southern next Saturday, Sept. 9, in Statesboro.

STATESBORO, Ga. - The UAB football team fell to Georgia Southern 49-35 at Allen E. Paulson Stadium on Saturday night.

UAB outgained Georgia Southern 477-462 for the game, and Jacob Zeno threw for a career-high 385 yards, but Georgia Southern's balanced offensive attack proved too much for the Blazers.

Tejhaun Palmer notched his second career 100-yard game with six catches for 102 yards, while tight end Bryce Damous (7 catches, 47 yards, TD) and Iverson "Strap" Hooks (6 catches, 80 yards) each set career highs in receptions, while Hooks' 80 yards were also a new career high.

Defensively, Keondre Swoopes returned to the field after missing Week 1 and led the Blazers with nine stops. The Eagles quarterback Davis Brin through, threw for 318 yards and two touchdowns while he, OJ Arnold and Jalen White all rushed for a touchdown.

The Blazers fumbled on the first play of the game which Georgia Southern turned into seven points just four plays later on a 5-vard touchdown pass.

GASO went ahead 14-0 with 2:56 left in the opening quarter with a Davis Brin's second touchdown pass of the game, this time a 4-yard completion.

However, the Blazers responded with a 22-point second quarter to claw back into the game. Jermaine Brown Jr. got the Blazers on the board with a 19-yard touchdown run at the 14:15 mark of the second.

The Eagle surged ahead 21-7 as running back OJ Arnold tossed a 26-yard touchdown pass, but UAB scored 15-unanswered points and took its first lead of the game of the game with 1:44 left in the half.

Following a 5-yard touchdown pass from Zeno to Damous, Isaiah Jacobs scored on UAB's next possession, and the Blazers' 2-point conversion was good as Harrison Barker rushed it in for a 22-21 lead. A late 39-yard touchdown run from GASO's Arnold gave the Eagles a 28-22 halftime lead.

The two teams traded touchdowns in the third as UAB's came courtesy of an 8-yard pass from Zeno to Hooks, and the two teams went into the fourth with Georgia Southern leading 35-29.

The Eagle offense started the 4th quarter with 11 unanswered points, swelling the lead to 46-29. Zeno took in a 1-yard touchdown on a quarterback sneak to bring down the deficit to 46-35, but a failed onside kick and a late Georgia Southern field goal with 1:36 left to play put the game out of reach with a final score of 49-35.

UAB looks to bounce back when the Blazers host Louisiana next week at Protective Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled for 6 p.m.

BIRMINGHAM — The UAB football team fell to Louisiana 41-21 on Saturday night at Protective Stadium.

After a scoreless first quarter, the two teams entered an hour and 51-minute weather delay. Following the delay, Louisiana (2-1) outscored UAB 24-0 in the second quarter and ultimately built a 38-point lead which was too large for the Blazers (1-2) to overcome.

Jacob Zeno was 27-of-38 for 280 yards, one touchdown and two interceptions, while he added 98 rushing yards and a touchdown. However, he only netted 52 rushing yards after being sacked seven times.

Louisiana outgained UAB 513-386 for the game and had 305 total rushing yards. Keondre Swoopes had a game-high 10 tackles and in two games this season is averaging 9.5 tackles per game. Michael Moore had a career high nine

Following the scoreless first quarter, Louisiana had a fresh set of downs at UAB's 20-yard line when play resumed and two plays later Michael Fairbanks II forced a fumble which Fish McWilliams recovered to give the ball back to the Rlazers

However, Louisiana seized control of the game midway through the second quarter with 24 unanswered points. All three of the Ragin' Cajuns touchdowns were rushing scores, including an 80-yard rush from quarterback Zeon Chriss, who had two in the quarter.

Louisiana added 10 points in the third and led UAB 34-3 after three.

UL added another score in the fourth, but UAB scored the final 18 points of the game on a Zeno rush, a touchdown catch from Samario Rudolph and a rushing score from running back Lee Beebe.

The Blazers are back in action next Saturday, Sept. 23 at No. 1 Georgia. Kickoff is set for 7:30 p.m. ET/6:30 p.m. CT on ESPN2.

ATHENS, Ga. – The UAB football team put forth a valiant effort but ultimately fell short at No. 1 Georgia by the score of 49-21 on Saturday night at Sanford Stadium.

UAB quarterback Jacob Zeno accounted for all three UAB touchdowns with two passing and one rushing. He finished the game 32-of-51 for 250 yards and helped UAB (1-3) compile 336 total yards of offense.

However, the Bulldogs (4-0) gained 582 yards of total offense, led by quarterback Carson Beck who was 22-of-32 for 338 yards and three touchdowns. His top target was All-American tight end Brock Bowers who finished the game with nine catches for 121 yards and two touchdowns.

UAB won the turnover battle 3-1, highlighted by running back Lee Beebe recovering two fumbles on special teams. His first recovery late in the first quarter led directly to a UAB touchdown which tied the game at 7-7.

Defensively, safety lke Rowell led the Blazer with eight tackles, a forced fumble and a TFL. Keondre Swoopes and Damien Miller each had six tackles and Miller forced two fumbles.

Georgia scored on the game's opening possession to take an early 7-0 lead, but the UAB defense held strong and UAB eventually tied the game at 7-7 with 14:09 left in the second quarter on a 4-yard pass from Zeno to Bryce Damous.

However, the Bulldogs scored the next 21 points to surge ahead 28-7 with 1:26 remaining in the half. The Blazers responded with an excellent hurry-up drive which was capped by Amare Thomas' first career touchdown reception, making the score 28-14 at the half.

Georgia, who has not allowed a point in the third quarter this season, added two touchdowns in the quarter to gain a 42-14 lead entering the final 15 minutes.

Each team scored a touchdown in the fourth for the final score of 49-21.

UAB now turns its attention to conference action and plays its first-ever AAC game next Saturday at Tulane. Kickoff is scheduled for 11 a.m. on ESPN2.

NEW ORLEANS — The UAB football team suffered a 35-23 loss in its American Athletic Conference opener on Saturday afternoon at Tulane.

The Blazers (1-4, 0-1 AAC) gained 434 yards of total offense, including a season-high 170 rushing yards, but Tulane had 448 yards, including 264 on the ground to lead the Green Wave (4-1, 1-0 AAC) to victory.

With UAB trailing by five with less than a minute remaining in the contest, Tulane quarterback Michael Pratt found Lawrence Keys III on 4th-and-9 for a 32-vard touchdown to ice the game.

UAB quarterback Jacob Zeno was 27-of-35 for 236 yards, and his top target was freshman Amare Thomas who finished with eight catches for 99 yards. Running back Isaiah Jacobs had career highs in carries (18), yards (95) and touchdowns (2), while Matt Quinn accounted for the rest of the scoring as he was 3-for-3 on field goals from 31, 48 and 36 yards.

Defensively, Damien Miller and Michael Moore had a team-high seven tackles, while Moore had one of UAB's four TFLs. UAB also recovered two fumbles and now has eight fumble recoveries on the season which ranks top three nationally.

Highlighted by a 35-yard end around from wide receiver Brandon Buckhaulter, the Blazers took their opening drive 65 yards in 11 plays and capped it with a 31-yard field goal from Quinn.

Tulane answered with 2:50 left in the first on a 15-yard rush from Yulkeith Brown, but UAB then tallied 17-straight points in the second quarter to surge ahead 20-7.

Jacobs scored two rushing touchdowns within a three-minute span early in the quarter, and Quinn added a season-long 48-yard field goal to cap UAB's scoring run. Jacobs' second touchdown was set up Desmond Little forcing a fumble which Nikia Eason Jr. recovered in Tulane territory.

However, Tulane scored on its final possession of the first half and the opening possession of the second half to take a 21-20 lead with 13:35 left in the third. Both Tulane touchdowns were rushing scores by Makhi Hughes, who finished the game with 123 rushing yards.

The Green Wave added to its lead with 2:50 left in the third as Pratt found tight end Alex Bauman for a 14-yard touchdown in the corner of the end zone, extending Tulane's lead to 28-20.

With the Blazers trailing by eight early in the fourth, UAB drove all the way down to the Tulane 1-yard line, but Zeno fumbled on an attempted quarterback sneak which the Green Wave recovered in the end zone.

Quinn's third field goal of the game cut the Tulane lead to 28-23 with 4:52 left, but the Green Wave was able to keep possession of the ball and converted on the 4th-and-9 to secure the victory.

The Blazers return to Protective Stadium next Saturday, Oct. 7, to host USF. Kickoff is scheduled for either 2:30 or 3 p.m. and that determination will be made on Sunday.
